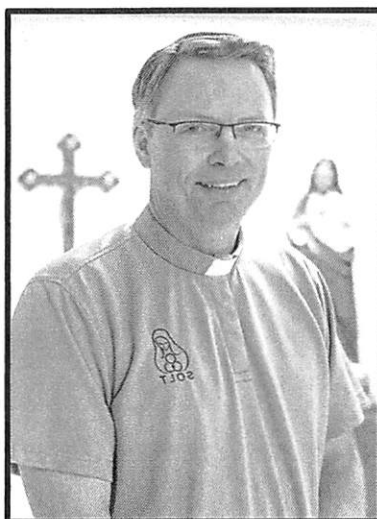

Parish Lenten Mission Speaker

Fr. Peter Marsalek, General Priest Servant SOLT



Fr. Peter Marsalek is a priest with the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity, originally from Burlington, Ontario, Canada. Ordained a priest on January 28, 2005, Fr. Peter has served as an Associate Pastor of a parish in Rome, the Director of Religious Education for the Diocese of Corpus Christi, Texas, President of St. John Paul II High School, professor of dogmatic theology at Sts. Cyril and Methodius Seminary, rector of the SOLT house of studies, and currently serves as the General Priest Servant for the SOLT community.

Fr. Peter obtained his doctorate in sacred theology from the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome. Prior to attending seminary, Fr. Peter graduated with a master's degree in civil engineering from Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario, Canada, and was a three-time university tennis champion.
