This publication is a companion to The Novena To The Holy Spirit published by the Spiritans in 1995. While the 1995 edition is suitable for both public and private devotion, this leaflet provides a personal format that may be more familiar to those who used our earlier editions. Devotion to the Holy Spirit is an inherent part of our faith and our prayer life. Thus, this Novena is appropriate for use, not only in the days preceding Pentecost, but at any time throughout the year.

# ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE HOLY SPIRIT
