



A FUTURE SAINT OF THE HOLY EUCHARIST



Blessed Carlo Acutis (3 May 1991 – 12 October 2006) was a 15-year-old Italian website designer who documented Eucharistic miracles and approved Marian apparitions, and catalogued them both on a website he designed before his death from leukemia.

From a young age, Carlo had a special love for God, even though his parents would not attend Holy Mass. They would only attend his First Holy Communion and for the mom's Confirmation, and the wedding in the Church. After his First Holy Communion he went to Mass as often as possible at his parish which was across the street from his elementary school. Carlo's love for the Eucharist also inspired a deep conversion for his mother. It is amazing but true, but Carlo would

actually encourage his parents and relatives to attend Mass every day with him.....not the other way around.

When Carlo was 7 years old he said, "To be always close to Jesus, that's my life plan." He also said when he was a teenager, "The Eucharist is the highway to Heaven. When people sit in the sun, they get a tan, but when they sit before the Eucharistic Jesus, they become saints."

Carlo was an average student, but he had a great love for the unborn, the poor, and for students who were being bullied just like he was being bullied. He also taught himself about computers, and played video games with his gaming buddies, but limited his gaming to 2 hours per week! He would evangelize his buddies by inviting them to come to Holy Mass and go to Confession. With the help of his family, he put together an exhibition on Eucharistic miracles that has gone on to be displayed at thousands of parishes on 5 continents.

When he was only 15, he was diagnosed with an aggressive form of leukemia, and he died on October 12, 2006. He was buried with his athletic warm-up jacket, pants, and Nike sneakers on -- clothes he was used to wearing every day. (SEE BACKSIDE.)

In February 2020, Pope Francis recognized a miracle attributed to Carlo's intercession, so Carlo became a "Blessed" in the Church. In July 2022 a second miracle was attributed to Carlo, so now Carlo is now on his way to becoming a saint. "Blessed Carlo Acutis, pray for us."

You made him become enamored with Your Son Jesus, Making of the Eucharist his "Highway to Heaven".
You gave him Mary, as a most loving Mother, and, with the Rosary, you made him a poet of her tenderness. Receive his prayer for us. Above all, gaze upon the poor, whom he loved and helped.
Grant for me too, by his intercession, the grace that I need ...
And make our joy fulfilled, placing Carlo among the Saints of your Church, so that his smile may shine again for us in the glory of your name. Amen
