

## PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE SOULS IN PURGATORY November 1st to the 8th

From the time of the ancient Church we have honored, respected and prayed for the dead. We cannot be received into Heaven without having been fully purified from the consequences of our personal sins we committed during this life. Souls in purgatory suffer, paying for any temporal punishment which remains due to their sins, from which they have not yet been fully purified, even though they are already forgiven. God provides a great opportunity for us to love and help the suffering souls in purgatory by performing acts of devotion and charity. These acts provide remission from temporal punishment for the departed souls and are called indulgences. A soul who receives the benefit of a plenary indulgence will be ready to go to heaven. A plenary indulgence may be granted each and every day from November 1st to November 8th.

Requirements for obtaining a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory:

Devoutly visit a cemetery any or all the Days from Nov. 1st to Nov. 8th and:

- 1) there pray, if only mentally, for the faithful departed souls in purgatory
- 2) Pray for the pope's intentions (an Our Father and Hail Mary, or other appropriate prayer, is sufficient).
- 3) Receive Sacramental confession within 20 days of these prayers.
- 4) Receive Eucharistic communion (one plenary indulgence may be earned per reception).
- 5) Have no attachment to sin (even venial) i.e., it is sufficient that the Christian makes an act of the will to love God and despise sin.
- 6) One must do these works of prayer while living in the state of grace, free from mortal sin.
