VERY IMPORTANT NEW MEXICO BALLOT PROPOSALS FOR NOV. 7, 2023 ELECTIONS!

THE FOLLOWING BILLS THAT WERE PASSED BY OUR NEW MEXICO STATE LEGISLATURE THIS YEAR ARE NEEDING YOUR IMPORTANT ATTENTION, AND **OUR COUNTY NEEDS 628 SIGNATURES** FROM REGISTERED VOTERS TO VOTE ON THEM IN NOVEMBER. **THE SIGNATURES ARE DUE BY FRIDAY, JUNE 16, 2023.**

1) HB 7: REPRODUCTIVE & GENDER AFFIRMING HEALTHCARE FREEDOM ACT:

- (1) The bill language gives our minors unrestricted access to receive abortion or transgender interventions and no parental notification is required.
- (2) No protections are offered for religious beliefs or matters of conscience for those who do not wish to participate in or even refer someone to these interventions.
- (3) The bill prohibits New Mexico state or local governments from creating or enforcing any law, ordinance, policy, or regulation that violates or conflicts with this bill.
- (4) This bill will prevent prosecution of anyone who allows the death of a baby born-alive from a botched attempt at a late term abortion.

2) SB 13: REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH PROVIDER PROTECTION ACT:

- (1) SB 13 violates freedom of speech by silencing all electronic forms of pro-life speech that would be used to deter an individual from seeking, providing, or receiving abortions or transgender interventions.
- (2) SB 13 gives no age restrictions or requirements of parental notification for a minor to receive these services and then protects a provider or facilitator from being prosecuted for performing services without parental consent.
- (3) SB 13 violates separation of powers between states as enshrined in the 10th Amendment of the US Constitution by allowing enforcement of a subpoena or judgment of a court in another state.

3) SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS:

- (1) Students of all ages will now have direct access to a number of services including multiple forms of birth-control, referrals for abortions, gender-transitioning counseling, and provision of hormone blockers, all without parental notification.
- (2) Healthcare providers who work within these School-based health centers will be required to provide services including abortions and transgender interventions regardless of moral or religious objections.
- (3) School-based health centers further drive wedges between parents and their children with access to these dangerous and permanent procedures without parents' knowledge or consent. Our children deserve help, not harm.
