Fr. James Blount SOLT (Lenten Parish Mission Speaker)



Fr. James Blount SOLT is a priest of the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity – North American Regio. A very gifted Spiritual Director and Confessor, Fr. Jim is a bold, charismatic preacher endowed and empowered with the gifts of the Holy Spirit. After his ordination in 1999, Father's first mission assignment was as pastor of Divine Mercy Catholic Church in Belize City, Belize. There while overseeing several missions, Father served as Spiritual Director of the Charismatic movement for the country. During his 9 years in the Belize SOLT Mission, Fr. Blount working directly with his Bishop, was instrumental in spearheading the development of a Catholic Evangelization-Communications Center which to date produces multi media programming under the title – Guadalupe Media.

Father's preaching focusses on living one's life in personal relationship with each of the Persons of the Holy Trinity; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. He is deeply involved with the *Flame of Love* movement (flameoflove.us) and he likewise promotes the *Divine Will* devotion, both of which have received Imprimaturs and approval of the Holy Catholic Church. Father's talks help to increase awareness not only of the beauty of the Catholic Faith; but also of the "signs of the times" in light of the intense spiritual battle in our present world (where evil continues to wage war against the Sacred thus aiming toward the destruction of holy family life). Fr. Jim's humble boldness and untiring drive to minister to the lost and ill are particularly noteworthy; bringing relief to thousands.
