

R.C.I.A

Rite of Christian of Adults (RCIA) is a process by which adults become full, participating members of the Catholic faith. Participants, known as catechumens go through a multi-step process of studying the Gospel, nurturing their relationship with God, becoming familiar with the Catholic teachings and practices, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation). The RCIA process also sets the foundation for the ongoing journey of discipleship that lasts throughout one's life.

St. Gertrude Church extends an invitation to all who wish to become members of the Catholic faith. Those who need to go through the RCIA process in order to become full members of the Catholic faith include:

- Someone who is of another faith and wishes to convert to Catholicism.
- An individual who was baptized in another Christian denomination and wishes to become a member of the Catholic faith.
- Someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church, but never received the Sacraments of Communion & Confirmation.

If you or someone you know want to become full members of the Catholic Church, please come by the office and register for the RCIA program. Additionally, the classes will be open to anyone who wishes to "brush up" on their Catholic knowledge.
